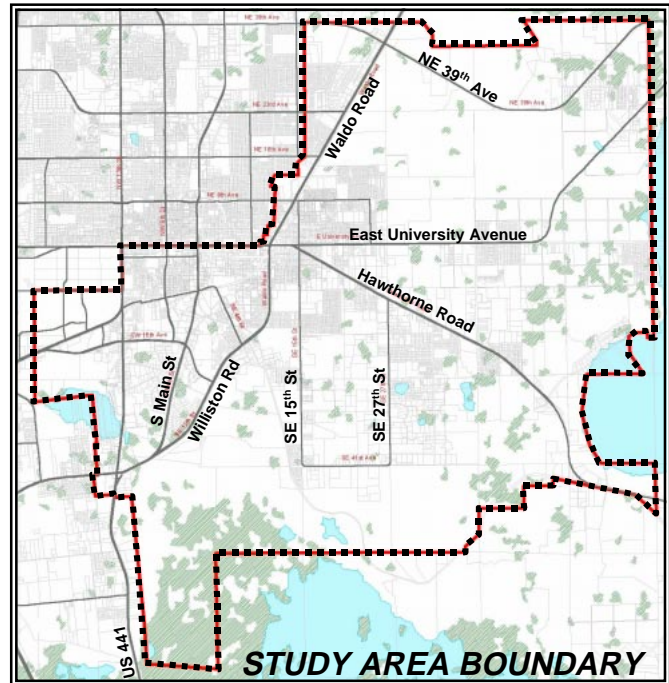


# PLAN EAST GAINESVILLE COMMUNITY DESIGN CHARRETTE- APRIL 4-7

*The purpose of this charrette is to prepare an action plan for the revitalization of East Gainesville that addresses development, land conservation and transportation needs.*

Plan East Gainesville, or PEG, is a study coordinated by the Metropolitan Transportation Planning Organization (MTPO) with the City, County and Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). The MTPO for the Gainesville Urbanized Area is made up of the Mayor and four City of Gainesville Commissioners, the five Alachua County Commissioners and non-voting members from the University of Florida and the FDOT. The MTPO's role is to coordinate, set priorities and establish policy guidance for the transportation planning in the Gainesville metropolitan area.



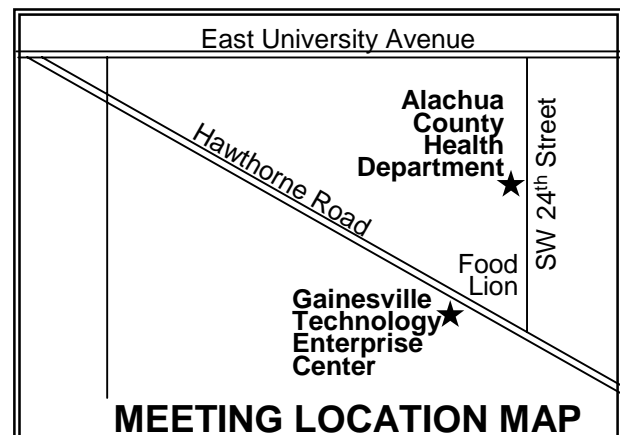
